MEP calls for support for Malta Initiative

MEP Simon Busuttill called on the European Commission and the Council of Ministers to support the Malta Initiative to promote a Euro-Arab structured dialogue.

Dr Busuttill was addressing the plenary of the European Parliament which was debating a report on what strategy the EU should adopt with regards to reform in the Arab world. The report was drafted by former French Prime Minister Michel Rocard.

Dr Busuttill said that this subject required a deep understanding of the Arab world. He said that whereas it was clear that the Arab world needed to undertake substantial reform to face modernisation and globalisation, Europe nevertheless needed to be careful not to be patronising by dictating solutions to Arab countries as if it was the party that knew best.

Rather, Europe should offer its experience on unity and its support in a spirit of partnership between equals.

Dr Busuttill said that the European Union needed to engage better with Arab interlocutors such as the Arab League which had become a credible entity with an important voice in the Arab world.

Referring to the Malta Initiative launched by Foreign Minister Michael Frendo, Dr Busuttill said that a structured dialogue between the EU and the Arab League should be actively promoted as a forum for debating reforms on both sides of the Mediterranean. Dr Busuttill called upon the European Commission and the Council of Ministers to support the Malta Initiative.

Full text of speech follows:

Grazzi sur President,

Is-sugġett tar-riformi fid-dinja Għarbija huwa sugġett kumpless ħafna u biżżejjed wiehed jaqra r-rapport li għandna quddiemna biex jifhem din il-kumplessita'.

Fil-fatt ir-rapporteur jistaqsi jekk hemmx, fil-fatt, "komunita' Għarbija" u jfakkar li mhux ta' b'xejn li nitkellmu dwar id-"dinja Għarbija" iżda mhux dwar "in-nazzjon Għarbi" jew "l-għaqda Għarbija"¹

Dan juri biċ-ċar li qabel nitkellemu dwar id-dinja Għarbija u noffru s-soluzzjonijiet, jehtieġ li l-ewwel għandna nifhmu aktar u aħjar lid-dinja Għarbija.

U huwa għalhekk importanti ferm li meta nitkellmu dwar riformi fid-dinja Għarbija noqgħodu attenti li ma nkunux patronizzanti u ma niddettawx is-soluzzjonijiet daqs li kieku aħna nafu aktar minn haddieħor.

M'hemmx dubju li għad hemm bżonn bosta riformi fid-dinja Għarbija biex il-pajjiżi Għarab ikunu jistgħu jisfruttaw il-proċess ta' modernizzazzjoni u globalizzazzjoni aħjar.

Iżda daqstant ieħor xogħolna huwa li noffru l-esperjenza ta' għaqda tagħna u l-appoġġ tagħna fi spirtu ta' shubija bejn żewġ partijiet ugwali u mhux f'kuntest ta' "*aħna ngħidulkom x'għandkom tagħmlu*". Il-proċess ta' Barcellona suppost li kien proċess ta' shubija, iżda kullhadd jaf li, fil-fatt, spicċajna bi proċess fejn hija l-UE li tiddetta x'għandu jsir, kif u meta.

U jeħtieġ ukoll li nużaw aħjar interlokuturi fid-dinja Għarbija bħalma hija l-Lega Għarbija li, bid-diffikultajiet kollha, illum għandu biżżejjed kredibilita' biex tagħti vuċi lid-dinja Għarbija.

Malta ħadet l-inizjattiva li tipproponi djalogu strutturat bejn l-Unjoni Ewropea u L-Lega Għarbija - djalogu li jitratta s-sugġett tar-riformi li rridu niffaccjaw fuq iż-żewġ naħat tal-Mediterran. Din hija inizjattiva tajba li diġa ntlagħhet tajjeb mil-Lega Għarbija stess u nittama li kemm il-Kunsill kif ukoll il-Kummissjoni jagħtuha l-appoġġ tagħhom.
